General Cost Information

Please note - not all costs will be applicable to every program

- · Tuition: Base cost for each credit a student is enrolled in, based on residency (ND Resident, MN Reciprocity, U.S. Resident, International). For tuition/fee rates and residency applications, visit NDSCS.edu/Costs.
- Per-Credit Fees: ConnectND, NDSA, Student and Technology. Fees shown are based on the primary location selected for this estimate (Wahpeton, Fargo, or Online); actual costs will be calculated based on the location of each class enrolled in. (ConnectND, NDSA, Student and Technology fees cap at 12 credits per semester.)
- · Instructional Fees: Charged per credit and calculated based on the prefixes of the classes a student is enrolled in. (Instructional fees do not cap at 12 credits.)
- Online Access Fee: \$38.00/credit for classes taken online. (Online Access fees do not cap at 12 credits.)
