

EMERGENCY QUICK GUIDE

In the event of an emergency, you will receive a text, phone call and email notification from the NDSCS campus emergency notification system.

Fire/Evacuation

- Activate nearest fire alarm
- Call Fire Department, relay location and information
- If conditions allow, try to suppress fire with fire extinguisher
- Calmly proceed to nearest exit
- DO NOT use elevators
- Assist with the disabled if you are able
- Meet at designated assembly areas
- · Re-enter only when authorized

Shelter In Place

- Pay attention to emergency alerts
- Stay inside, lock windows and doors
- Do not use elevators
- Use your phone only as necessary
- Follow any instructions given by Emergency Response Officials

Hazardous Material Spill

- Control source of spill if possible
- If necessary, shut off sources of ignition
- Evacuate the area and notify authorities
- Give all known info to responders: name, location, substance
- Do not re-enter until authorized to do so



Tornado/Severe Weather

Watch: Conditions are favorable

Warning: Weather is occurring

- Stay calm and seek shelter in the lowest level of a building or interior hallway
- If outside, shelter in ditch or low-lying area
- DO NOT pull the fire alarm
- Stay away from windows
- Remain in area until all clear message is received



- Report all threats or relevant information to 911 and Campus PD
- Do not handle suspicious packages
- Evacuate the area at least 500 feet from building
- Follow all instructions and to not return until given clearance



- Run Only if it is safe to escape, leave all belongings behind
- Hide Go to nearest room, lock doors, silence phones, turn off lights, barricade doors
- Fight only as a last resort and as if your life depends on it
- Call 911 when it is safe for you to do so
- DO NOT sound fire alarms
- Obey all directions from police
