- Located on the west side of the Student Center
- Three floors

- Unlimited access laundry facilities on every floor
- TV lounge and study lounge located on upper floors

# **LOFTING and BUNKING BEDS**

Lofting a bed means using a "lofting kit" to raise your bed off the floor. Bunking a bed means putting one bed above the other. A limited supply of loft kits are rented per academic year on a first come, first serve basis, with a signed rental agreement form. The non-refundable rental fee will be charged to your student account. The residence halls that have lofting and bunking capabilities are Robertson, Riley, Forkner and Nordgaard halls. Walton/Schulz beds are loftable.

Wireless Internet access are available in all residence halls. All halls contain kitchens with refrigerator, stove and microwave and cable TV in the lounges.
