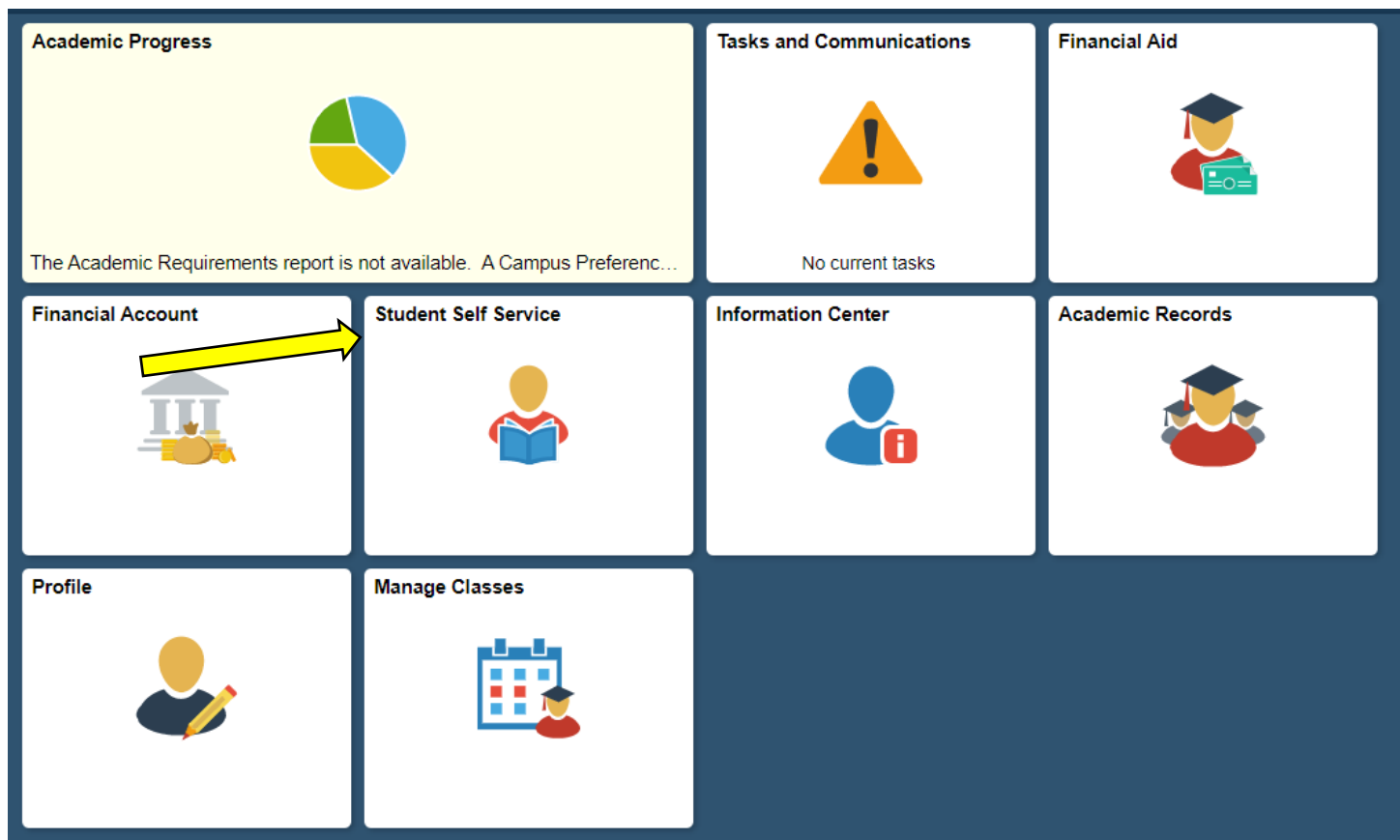

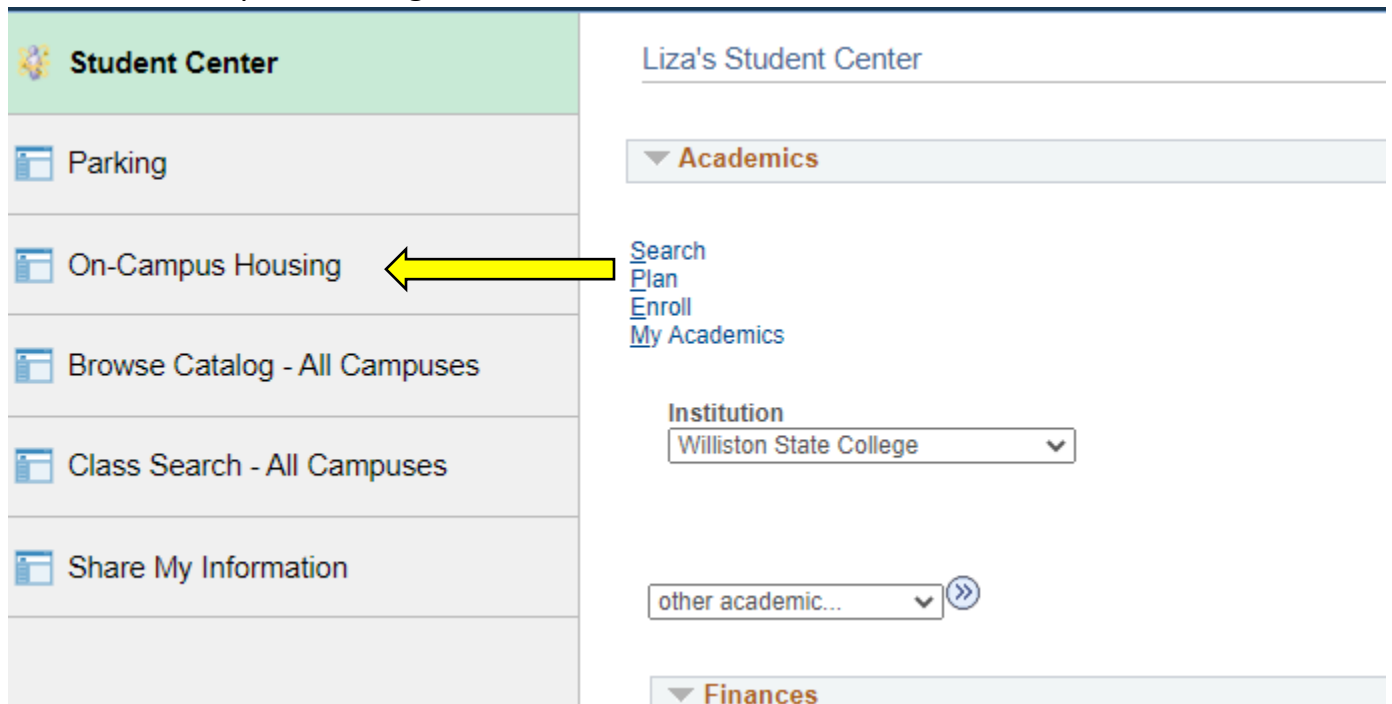




6. Select ND State College of Science, and Continue
